

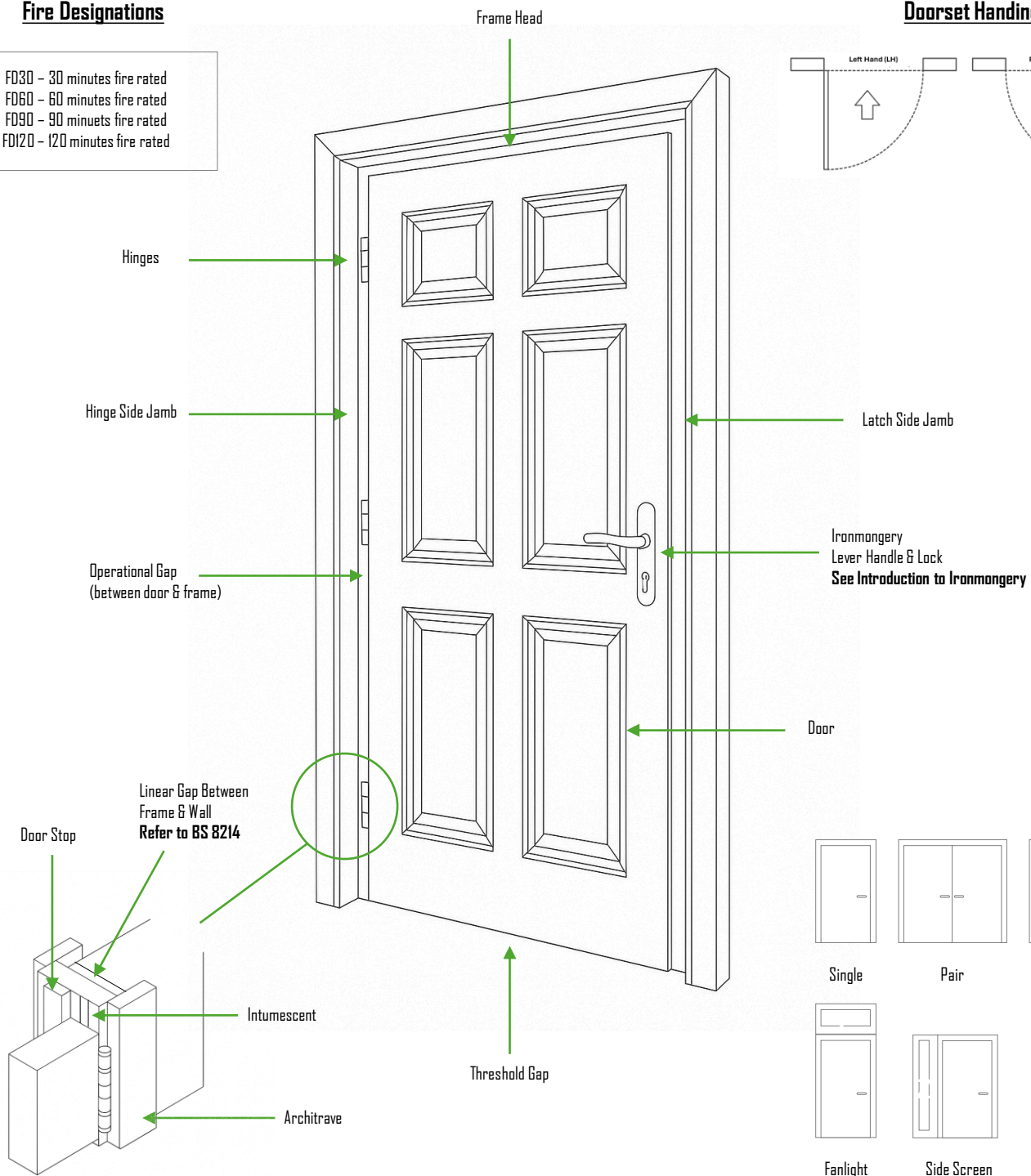
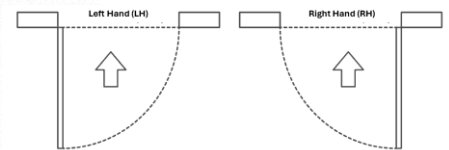
Introduction to Doorset Arrangements

To specify doorsets effectively, it is important to first understand the basics, the arrangements and the key terminology involved. A doorset is the combination of a door leaf, its frame, and all the necessary hardware that allows the system to operate as a single, integrated unit. One of the main advantages of specifying a complete doorset is that all these components are tested together. This ensures consistency in performance for aspects such as fire safety, security, and durability.

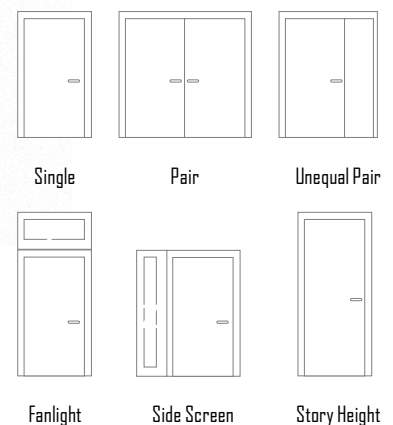
Fire Designations

FD30 – 30 minutes fire rated
FD60 – 60 minutes fire rated
FD90 – 90 minutes fire rated
FD120 – 120 minutes fire rated
